Community Supplies:

36 <u>TICONDEROGA sharpened</u> #2 pencils
6 large pink erasers (not "Foohy" kind)
6 SMALL glue sticks
2 regular size boxes of Kleenex
2 red correcting pens
4 pkgs. wide ruled binder paper
2 highlighters any color
1 pkg. colored pencils - Crayola
1 pkg. of <u>Twistables - type crayon</u>
1 pkg. white board markers
3 spiral notebooks - wide ruled
Personal Supplies:
Backpack (NO WHEELS)
Large, nylon, sturdy pencil pouch for binder (NO PENCIL BOXES)
1 black fine point Sharpie
1 pair of scissors
1 folder with bottom packers for the binder
3 ring binder with inside pockets (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. ~ no trapper keepers)
10 binder divider tabs (Plastic ones are nice. They don't tear out.)

The following is the instructions for binder set-up. <u>Please</u> have this ready to go for the first day.

Your child will be using a 3-ring binder this year. This can be quite a challenge. It must be at school daily and is an important part of your child's study skills program. If it is left at home, your child will be missing materials necessary for daily studies. He/she will have to call home, and have it brought in or have an immense amount of work to makeup. PLEASE check <u>frequently</u> to see that the binder is complete and CLEAN!

Prior to the first day of school, the dividers should be labeled as follows, starting from the beginning of the binder and progressing toward the back. It is easiest if the first section's divider is the one closest to the top of the page.
